COMPOSITION

90% Merlot Noir & 10% Cabernet-Sauvignon

DENSITY

5 500 plants/ha

YIELD

52 hectoliters/ha

HARVESTING

The Hospital grapes were harvested from September 8 at optimum ripeness for the Merlot and until September 29 for the Cabernet Sauvignon.

WINEMAKING

The grapes are destemmed and lightly crushed before being placed in temperature-controlled stainless steel vats. Vatting lasts between 15 and 21 days, depending on the grape varieties and batches harvested.

MATURATION

To preserve the fruit, 80% in stainless steel tanks and 20% for structure in barrels.



EYE

Wine with a ruby color, velvety with hints of mauve and pink.



NOSE

The nose is fine, with aromas of black and stone fruit, dried meat and Sichuan pepper.



MOUTH

Fruity, full-bodied experience that covers the entire palate, after a generous attack of slightly spicy myrtle and red fruit flavors.
